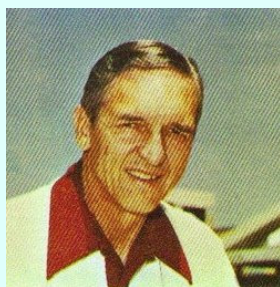

Charles H. "Chuck" Moser (September 9, 1918 - May 8, 1995) was the football coach guiding Abilene High School to a 49-game winning streak from 1954-57, which is still a Texas state record for 4A and 5A schools (though tied by Southlake Carroll HS in 2004-07). [1] Moser also served as assistant to Emory Bellard at Texas A&M

University.

On Chuck Moser Day each spring our club honors athletes and coaches presenting the Chuck & Doris Moser Scholarship Award to an Abilene student.
